To Whom it May Concern:

We have filed temporary rules effective December 5, 2011. A copy of the temporary certificate and statement of need is enclosed. In October we filed a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) with corresponding Statements of Need and Fiscal Impact for these rules, but that rule making will not be final until January. We anticipate filing final rules effective January 3, 2012.

The rule changes are summarized as follows:

OAR 137-055-1140 (Confidentiality of Records in the Child Support Program): this rule is being amended to remove a reference to the partner access rule and replace it with a reference to federal regulation.

OAR 137-055-1145 (Access to Child Support Records): this rule is being suspended because provisions for access are now covered in federal regulation.
