

Parenting Plans in the Child Support Program

Working Together

The Oregon Child Support Program has received federal grant funds to help interested parties establish parenting plans that may be filed with a child support order.

There is no cost to you for this service!

1. Oregon Child Support Program staff can provide you with a referral to a mediator in your area who will help you and the other parent develop a parenting plan; **or**
2. You can create your own parenting time plan by accessing the Oregon Judicial Department parenting plans and forms at:
